API Key Management

Enter Console > Access Now to manage, click Create API Key.

After creation, enter API Key Management, where you can perform operations such as adding new, viewing, deleting, and remarking API Keys.

Note:

An API KEY is a security authentication credential for large model API requests. To ensure the security of your property and services, please keep your API KEY secure and do not upload or publicly share your KEY information in any way.

Root account and sub-account can both create API KEYs.

Note: The maximum number of API KEYS for root accounts and sub-accounts combined is 10.

Data Report

Enter the Console > Data Report, where you can select APIs and models to view usage details. It supports filtering by dimensions such as accounts and API keys.

Resource Management

In Resource Management, you can view available, exhausted, and expired resource packages, including trial resources and exclusive concurrency packages. When a resource package is exhausted, it cannot be used. Please toggle on the postpaid switch in Postpaid Settings or proceed to purchase a prepaid concurrency package on the Purchase Page for later use.

Postpaid Settings

Enable Postpaid for Usage-Based Billing: LLM Knowledge Engine Basic API supports postpaid billing. If you need continuous service without downtime when resources are exhausted, you can enable the postpaid switch. This allows automatic switching to postpaid usage when the resource package is depleted. You can toggle on the billing switch in Postpaid Settings to use it.

Note:



- 1. Once enabled, when the resource pack is exhausted, charges are deducted from the account balance on an hourly basis using the postpaid method (each switch can be modified once per hour). When in payment overdue status, it cannot be used. You can view the account balance.
- 2. Deduction order: Experience Resource Package > Paid Resource Package > Postpaid. You can view bills in Console Expense Center.

Content Moderation Settings
