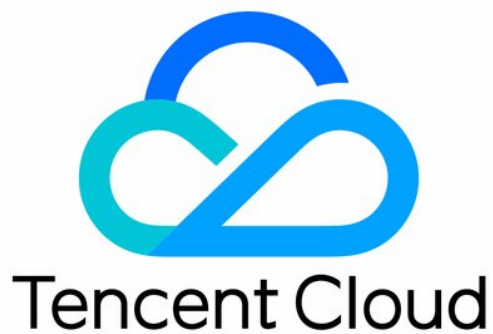

Individual Identity Verification Guide

Overview

This document describes how to verify individual identity for your Tencent Cloud account. After successful verification, the account and the Tencent Cloud resources under it will belong to you. You will be able to purchase or manage resources for individual businesses. However, you cannot purchase or use resources designated for organization businesses or apply for VAT invoices for them.

Note :

One ID card/passport/driver's license/work permit can be used to verify the identity of up to one Tencent Cloud account.

If your resources are in the Mainland China, and you want to apply for ICP filing for service in Mainland China in the future, please make sure that the name in identity verification is the same as that of the ICP filing entity; otherwise, ICP filing application will fail.

The following describes how to verify your individual identity in detail.

Prerequisites

You need to have a Tencent Cloud account. If you don't have an account, you can sign up for one as instructed in [Signing up for Tencent Cloud Account](#).

Step 1. Select individual identity verification

1. Log in to the Tencent Cloud Console and go to [Account Information](#), navigate to **Basic Information > Verification Status**, and click **Submit for Verification**.
2. Select "Individual Verification" and click **Verify Now**.

Step 2. Enter basic individual information

The International Tencent Cloud website allows you to verify your individual identity with your valid ID card/passport, driver's license, or work permit issued by the government agency of your account registration location. After completing all required information, please click **Submit**.

The Tencent Cloud team will review the application within two to three business days and notify you of the result through the console Message Center, email, and SMS.

Enterprise Identity Verification Guide

Overview

This document describes how to verify enterprise identity for your Tencent Cloud account. After successful verification, the account and Tencent Cloud resources under it will belong to your enterprise. You will be able to purchase and manage resources for enterprises, but will not be able to purchase or use resources designated for individual businesses.

Note :

One set of enterprise identity information (enterprise name/business number) can be used to verify the identity of up to five Tencent Cloud accounts.

Prerequisites

You need to have a Tencent Cloud account. If you don't have an account, you can sign up for one as instructed in [Signing up for Tencent Cloud Account](#).

Directions

Step 1. Select enterprise identity verification

1. Log in to the Tencent Cloud Console and go to [Account Information](#), navigate to **Basic Information > Verification Status**, and click **Submit for Verification**.
2. Select **Enterprise Verification**.

Step 2. Enter basic enterprise information

Enter the following enterprise information in the console:

1. Enterprise name.
2. Registered address.
3. Business Registration Number;
4. Photo for enterprise verification.

After entering the information above, click **Submit** to initiate identity verification.

The Tencent Cloud team will review the application within two to three business days and notify you of the result through the console Message Center, email, and SMS.

Identity Verification Change Guide

This document describes how to change the identity information of a Tencent Cloud account whose individual/enterprise identity has already been verified. The verified identity determines an account's ownership. After the identity of an account is verified, we recommend that you do not change the identity information arbitrarily.

Note:

There is no time limit on changing an individual identity to an enterprise identity. Other types of identity information change need to be made 30 days after last successful identity verification.

You can submit a [ticket](#) to withdraw the application at any time before the application is approved or rejected, and the originally verified entity will stay unchanged.

Resources and incurred fees are subject to the originally verified entity before the application is approved.

Step 1. Initiate modification of identity verification

1. Log in to the Tencent Cloud Console and go to [Account Information](#), navigate to **Basic Information > Verification Status**, and click **View/Change Verification**.
2. On the identity verification information page, click **Modify verification**.

Step 2. Select the verification type

Select the target verification type: individual or enterprise.

Changing individual verification to enterprise verification

1. Select **Enterprise Verification** and click **Verify Now**.
2. Enter the basic enterprise information.

Enter the following enterprise information in the console:

Enterprise Name.

Registered address.

Business Registration Number.

Photo for enterprise verification.

3. After entering the information, click **Submit**. The Tencent Cloud team will review the application within two to three business days and notify you of the result through the console Message Center, email, and SMS.

Changing individual verification to another individual verification

1. Select **Individual Verification** and click **Verify Now**.

2. The International Tencent Cloud website allows you to verify your individual identity with your valid ID card/passport, driver's license, or work permit issued by the government agency of your account registration location. After completing all required information, please click **Submit**.
